

Job Title: Psychiatric Rehabilitation Specialist

Job Description:

We are seeking a dedicated and compassionate individual to join our team as a Psychiatric Rehabilitation Specialist. This unique position involves serving in two integral roles within our organization. The successful candidate will spend 60% of their time providing psychiatric rehabilitation services at the Sally and Howard Levin Clubhouse during the work-ordered day, and 40% providing supportive services in independent living settings for individuals with developmental or intellectual disabilities in the Squirrel Hill community.

Clubhouse Responsibilities:

- Educate, engage, and support clubhouse participants in various work areas, particularly in the kitchen unit.
- Plan and implement social activities and maintain communication with external providers.
- Ensure participant rights are upheld, and safety and security are maintained.
- Provide crisis intervention and supportive counseling as needed.

Supported Living Responsibilities:

• Assist residents in developing and maintaining independent living skills.

- Develop rapport with residents and their families, implementing wellness and educational programs.
- Maintain regular communication with supervisory staff and attend team meetings.

Essential Competencies:

- Self-motivated, resourceful, and organized.
- Positive, enthusiastic, and compassionate.
- Ability to work an unconventional schedule, including Friday evenings and holidays.
- Must attend an employer-paid two-week out-of-town Clubhouse training program within two years of hire.

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in a human service field preferred, or equivalent combination of education and experience.
- Minimum 1 year of experience in direct service capacity.
- Experience in preparing nutritious meals is desirable.
- Knowledge of Jewish traditions and culture is a plus.
- Must have a satisfactory Pennsylvania Criminal History report, valid PA driver's license, satisfactory driving record, and proof of car insurance.
- Ability to lift 15 pounds and remain active throughout the day.
